



What Vendor's Need to Know for 2023:

- Anyone can be a vendor as long as the art items they are selling are handmade by themselves** (no third party vendor, no family member sales, just items made by you) **and are either a visual art item, clay art item, textile art item, stone and jewelry art item, woodcraft item, or an item considered to be a handcraft item.**
- Vendors are located outside of the Cultural Arts Center's front door in the circular driveway in marked off vendor areas the size of parking spaces (See attached pictures and diagrams).** **There are approximately 25 vendor spaces in this circular driveway** and more can be found on the grassy areas behind the driveway by the sidewalks should there be this need.
- The Circular driveway will be closed to all traffic and will be the primary method of load-in and load-out for vendors the day of show. Vendors will be parked in the paved parking area that faces S. Saint Andrews Street for ease of loading in and out. No vehicles can be parked on the grass behind the vendor or the driveway in front of the vendor.
- Vendors will be able to load in at 6 AM day of show but must be completely done with set up and parking their vehicles by 9 AM day of show.**
- Vendors will need to provide their own tables, display racks, tent covering, chairs, etc.** for their booth just like any other festival.
- Empty Bowls Dothan sales are from 11 am to 2:00 pm and you will be set up prior to the front door opening for bowls sale and food and can stay open if we continue to see customers coming to the booths for sale. The end of day must be 5 pm regardless.**
- Vendors will pay \$10 per booth** and the Cultural Arts Center reserves the right to designate what booth is yours, and if you are eligible to be a vendor based on pictures of your work.
- Revenue from Empty Bowl Sales goes to the Wiregrass Food Bank; Revenue from Vendor Fees goes to the Cultural Arts Center's Messy Space Arts Studio for students and supplies.
- Registration form is a JotForm and includes a way to pay your vendor fees online.**
