Fall Session 1 Art Adventures

The Cultural Arts Center will be offering the following arts after school classes in The Messy Space Studio starting the week of September 3, 2024 through October 30, 2024. Registration opens August 5, 2024. The Messy Space Studio is located on the backside of the Cultural Arts Center campus. Each class requires a minimum of 5 students for the class to make. Class Descriptions:

TUESDAYS AFTER SCHOOL: (9/3,10, 17, 24 10/1, 15, 22, 29. No class 10/8)

“Let’s Paint” with Ms. Eryn DeMoss, PRE-K 4 & KINDERGARTEN, 4:00-5:00 PM. Over the summer Ms. Eryn has been learning and scouting new ways to teach our youngest artists the skills needed for painting. Her lessons will focus on eye hand coordination, proper techniques for brush and color stick holding, working on staying in the lines when called for, and focus. Painting is a very broad term that includes many kinds of media, lots of cool subject matter, scissors for collages, and more. Let us show you what your Pre-K can do! **COST: \$80 for 8 classes.**

“Fall Focus: Watercolors and Paper Art” with Ms. Lynn Johnson: 3rd/4th grade, 4:00-5:00 PM. Over the summer Ms. Lynn has been working on a variety of ways to create fall images using watercolors and paper art, but not limited to collages. This class will take you through how to make the watercolors work on paper and how to make your brush do what you want with them. Add to this a variety of ways paper art can create fall images and you have 8 classes of fun. **COST: \$80 for 8 classes.**

“Return to the Basics: Focus on Painting” with Ms. Lisa, 5th-9th grade, 4:00-5:00 PM. Ms. Lisa has spent her summer playing with all kinds of media to bring new skills to the easel for you to learn. As this is an art class designed to improve your art skills and basic knowledge, Ms. Lisa will us a variety of media (tempera, watercolor, acrylic) to help you create and draw a variety of subject matter (animals, still life, people, landscapes, and abstracts) while focusing on important skills (color mixing, blending, contrast, focal point, and shadowing). Want to learn more about how the artist does it? She’s your girl! **COST: \$60 for 6 classes. NO CLASS 9/3 OR 9/10 FOR THIS TEACHER!**

WEDNESDAYS AFTER SCHOOL: (9/4, 11, 18, 25. 10/2, 16, 23,30. No class October 9)

“Clay World” with Ms. Olga, 3rd/4th graders 4:00-5:00 PM; 5th – 9th graders 5:00-6:00 PM. Come and enjoy the world of clay as only Ms. Olga can show it to you: all kinds of clay from polymer to bisque, to air dry and more. This session Ms. Olga will step up her game and introduce you to new ideas for making items that are both useful and fun! There will be an introduction to the wheel this session as well as some ceramic work too. **COST: \$80 for 8 classes**

“The Fantastic Four: 4 types of art you can create” with Ms. Ann, 1st/2nd graders, 4:00-5:00 PM. Ms. Ann spent the last month creating several projects you finish in 1-2 classes and take home, all inspired by artists then and now. 2 classes in Paper Art to include some of Tracy English’s colorful forms; 2 classes in directed drawings focusing on abstracts and pop art; 2 classes in weaving on a loom you make yourself and creating the rainbow; and 2 classes in Assemblages as we create a Chihuly project! (Some parental help will be needed on this one so come join the fun). Something new each week as we learn new forms of art! **COST: \$80 for 8 classes.**
