The Cultural Arts Center opens registration for children's art activities **MONDAY AUGUST 15TH** both in person and through Facebook. Classes are held in the Messy Space Studio located on the backside of the Cultural Arts Center campus (old 5th grade wing, yellow and orange doors). Registration ends **SEPTEMBER 4TH** so supplies can be purchased for classes. Classes this session will run through the week of October 3-7, just before Fall Breaks begin. There will be Fall Break Activities that we will also post at a later date.

Registration is simple:
