Camps offered week of JUNE 10-14:

Art by the Piece: grades 3rd-7th, June 10-14, Monday-Friday, 9 am-12 noon, Room 29 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Lisa Slaker. "Come work with creative artist Lisa Slaker as you "piece together" four major works of art, all using tiny pieces that when put together create a whole: Mosaics on wood; glass art on canvas; woven painting collage; puzzle piece design; dream catcher creation". COST: \$125. Need a minimum of 6 for class to make.

Nature Explora: grades PreK4/5 going into kindergarten, June 10-14, Monday-Friday, 9 AM-10 AM, Room 26 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Eryn DeMoss. "Come work with our Process Artist Eryn DeMoss as we take exploring nature together to the next level. Process Art is all about "the process of creating" art, and not the art itself. Through exploration of nature we will work on fine motor skills, eye hand coordination, and focus while we work with nature through soap foam painting; water gun resist art; balloon dart art; pour paint flowerpots; sand painting; and sidewalk chalk making. We are going to have fun!" COST: \$50. Need a minimum of 6 for class to make.

Camps offered week of JUNE 17-20:

Sculpey Jewelry Creations: *grades 3rd-6th grade, June 17-20, Monday-Thursday, 9 am-11 am, Room 28 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Olga McBride*. "Come see how this colorful form of clay can create the most interesting pieces of jewelry for you to wear. Earrings (pierced and non-pierced), necklaces, pins, hair barrettes, rings, bracelets and more. You create, we bake, you wear. Share them with your friends and family. No two

pieces alike and no one will have jewelry like you have!" **Cost: \$80.** Need a minimum of 6 for class to make.

Science Camp: grades 1st/2nd grade, June 17-20, Monday-Thursday, 9 am – 10 am, Room 29 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Ann Cotton. "Come explore all the ways science can be touched, exploded, change colors, create and grow, while we work on a few basic scientific principles: slime central; volcano making; robot art, marshmallow constellations, mirror symmetry, growing crystals, static electricity, green penny experiment, exploding paint rockets, and more. It's all hands on!" COST: \$50. Need a minimum of 5 for class to make.

Once A Week Classes in June:

Pottery class: grades 3rd-7th grade, Mondays June 3, 10, 17; 1:30-3 pm, Room 28 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Olga McBride. "Beginners to the more advanced student, come learn how to manipulate clay in its many forms: air dry, ceramic, modeling, and more. Did you know you can even paint with clay on canvas? Come learn how and let's get our hands dirty!" COST: \$30. Need a minimum of 6 for class to make.

Wind Chime Art: grades 1st/2nd grade, Mondays June 3, 10, 17; 2:00-3:00 pm, Room 29 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Ann Cotton. "Wind chimes make beautiful music, and in this class, we will create a new windchime each week to delight and awaken our musical senses!" COST: \$20. Need a minimum of 4 students for class to make.

Chihuly Creations: grades 1st-3rd grade, Wednesdays June 5, 12, 19; 2-3 p, Room 29 in the Messy Space Studio with Ms. Ann Cotton. "Dale Chihuly created some of the most awesome glass chandelier type creations that we will spend an hour each day for 3 days creating our own Chihuly type Chandelier: 1 to take home and 1 to hang up in the Messy Space with our names on it. We will also play around with ways to use Shrinky Dinks to create glass like bowls and spinners. We will be using hair dryers to help us with the creations, and there is a lot of hand tying, cutting, painting, drawing and more." **COST: \$40** *Need a minimum of 4 students for class to make.*
