### **The Messy Space Studio announces Winter Session 2023 Art Activities**

Returning to our regular class schedule gets students involved for 8 classes for children grades K-6<sup>th</sup> grade starting week of January 23, 2023 through March 22, 2023. These classes will work on the principles and elements of art in a variety of ways for each grade group. The Cultural Arts Center opens registration for children's art activities December 26, 2022, both in person, through Facebook, and on their website. Classes are held in the Messy Space Studio located on the backside of the Cultural Arts Center campus (old 5<sup>th</sup> grade wing, yellow and orange doors). Registration ends January 18, 2023, so supplies can be purchased for classes. The Cultural Arts Center is closed to the public December 19, 2022-January 2, 2023 so registration during this time frame should be done online.

Registration can be done in 2 ways: 1. Drop by the Cultural Arts Center lobby and pick up a registration form, fill it out and pay for your student's classes at the box office window. 2.
